Long ago we used small staples in the back of our projects to secure them to the plywood.

That's where the seagulls came into play. A Staple came through the front, the seagulls were glued on top to cover the hole.

We now use masonite, it stays flatter and the glue adheres to it much better. (No more staples)

Here are pictures taken of the lighthouse from our showroom. The various angles will help with shaping.

I used a wood burner that came with an assortment of brass tips. This picture shows one tip sanded down. I reshaped it to the right size (shape) for the bricks. The brass is soft which made it easier to shape.
